UNDER THE PROVISION OF THE “ASSAM SETTLEMENT OF FOREST COUPES AND MAHALS BY TENDER SYSTEM RULES, 1967” as adapted by the Government of Meghalaya, Sealed Tenders in prescribed form affixing Court Fee Stamp of Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred) only are invited to work out the mahals mentioned in the Scheduled “A” hereto annexed for the period as mentioned against each mahals and will be received by the Divisional Forest Officer, Garo Hills Division, Tura in his office upto 3.00 P.M. (IST) on 1st December, 2007.

(b) Every tenderer should state the maximum outright price which he is prepared to pay for mahals, which is estimated to be for an amount of 950 quintals of phuljharu during the period.

(c) The tenderer should furnish his full name, father's name (or husband's name if the tenderer is a woman) and full address with post office and Telegraph Office in the tender itself.

(d) The tenders should be addressed to the undersigned by designation and supercribed as “Tender for Phuljharu Mahal” and must be put in the tender box kept for the purpose in the office of them undersigned or sent by registered post to the undersigned. The tender box will be closed at 3.00 P.M. (I.S.T.) on the 14th December, 2007. No tender received by post or hand after the box is closed will be entitled for consideration and shall be treated as invalid.

(e) The tenders will be opened immediately after the closed of the tender box, unless for special reasons, the Divisional Forest Officer notifies otherwise in the office Notice Board.

(f) The tenderers should furnish a Registration Certificate/Certified Copy of the Registration Certificate under the Meghalaya Sales Tax Act, 1972, showing that the intending tenderer Registered under the Meghalaya Financial Sales Tax Act, 1972.

2. The tenders must be accompanied by the following documents.

(a) Receipted Treasury Challan of Bank Deposit at call on any branch of the State Bank of India or the Meghalaya Co-operative Apex Bank or any other Nationalized Bank showing the deposit earnest money of Rs. 500.00 (Rupees five hundred) for each mahal duly pledge to the Divisional Forest Officer, Garo Hills Division, Cash or money order will not be accepted in lieu of Treasury Challan or Bank Deposit at call earnest money deposit made in respect of previous sale, if any, will be considered as valid deposit for the present sales under consideration.

A tenderer belonging to any of the Schedule Caste or Schedule Tribes or any Other Backward Classes recognized by the State Government will be entitled to deposit 50% of the above Earnest Money provided that a certificate in original or a certified copy thereof in support of its claim to belong to any Schedule Castes or Schedule Tribes or any Other Backward Classes recognized by the State Government is enclosed with the tender as required under Clause 2 (f) of the Tender Notice.

(b) Signed declaration in the following forms :-

“I agree that I will not withdraw the tender offered by me during the time that will be required for intimation of an acceptance of the tender for the mahal being given to me, nor will I withdraw it afterwards should my tender be accepted. I withdraw it afterwards should my tender be accepted. If I withdraw the tender, then I am liable to pay the whole sum of the tender or such amount on account of the deficiency as in the opinion of the Chief Conservator of Forests, Meghalaya, Shillong may be considered necessary to make good the whole of the loss and damaged that may be suffered by the Government in consequence thereof and I shall pay the same and if I fall to pay it, then it will be recovered from me as an arrear of land revenue”.

(c) Upto - date Income-Tax and Clearance Certificate of State Tax in the prescribed form. When on Income Tax Clearance Certificate or Sale Tax Clearance Certificate has been submitted by the tenderer in connection with another sale, no fresh certificate will be necessary so long as the certificate submitted is valid that a true copies of the certificates attested by a Gazetted officer, MLA, President of the Anchalik Parishad. Chairman, Town Committee must be enclosed with the tender under consideration.

(d) Upto-date Professional Tax Clearance Certificate from the concerning District Councils Authority.

(e) If the tender is submitted on behalf of a Cooperative Society or a Firm or a joint stock company, then in addition to the requirements of (a) & (c) above-

(i) The original or certified copy of the registration certificate of the society, or the firm or the company given by the respective registration in Meghalaya.

(ii) The copy of the resolution authorizing the person who sign the tender to manage the businesses of such society, Firm or company, on its behalf.

(iii) Information regarding with authorized, subscribed and paid up capital of the concern.

(f) If the tender is submitted by a person belonging to any of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes, then in addition to the requirements of (a), (b) and (c) above, a certificate in original or a certified copy thereof in support of his claim to belong to such community from the President of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes, association or from the Deputy Commissioner of the District of the Sub-Divisional Officer of the Sub-Division within Territorial jurisdiction, the tenderer permanently resides.

(g) In case of tenderers belonging to the Non-Tribal Communities a certified copy of the Non Tribal Trading License issued by the District Council concerned should be submitted together with the tender paper.

3 (a) Though the tender will be received by the undersigned the order of the settlement will be passed by the respective competent authority as shown below-

- (i) The Governor of Meghalaya, when the value of the accepted tender exceeds Rs. 1,50,000.00/-.
- (ii) The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Meghalaya, Shillong when the value of the accepted tender exceeds Rs. 75,000.00/- but does not exceeds Rs.1,50,000.00/-.
- (iii) The Conservator of Forests, (HQ), Meghalaya, Shillong when the value of the accepted tender exceeds Rs. 50,000.00/- but does not exceeds Rs, 75,000.00/-.
- (iv) The Divisional Forest Officer, Garo Hills Division (T) when the value of accepted tender does not exceeds Rs.50,000.00/-.

(b) Where the Divisional Forest Officer, Garo Hills Division, is not competent authority for making the settlement he shall forward the tender paper with his comments to the Chief Conservator of Forests, Meghalaya, Shillong, who passes the orders in those cases where he is competent to do so and forward the other cases with his comments to State Government for orders.

4 (i) Subject to suitability and ability of the tender to perform the work satisfactorily, preference and concession in settlement of the mahal will be admissible in the following manner to person belonging to any Schedule Castes and Schedule Tribes or Other Backward Classes recognized by the State Government, provided the highest offer for the mahal does not exceed Rs. 1,00,000.00/- (Rupees one lakh).

(a) If the offer from a member of the above mentioned categories a persons is not below $92\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the recognized highest offer, the mahal shall be settled with such person at his on offer.

(b) Even if the offer from a member of the aforementioned categories a person is below $92\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the recognized highest offer, coupe or the mahal may at the discretion of the competent authority be settled with such persons at an amount $7\frac{1}{2}\%$ less than the recognized highest offer.

(2) The preference and the concession shall also be admissible in the following manner to a Co-operative Society, provided not less than 80 % of the members thereof are persons belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes and provided the recognized highest offer for the mahal does not exceed Rs. 1,00,000.00/- (Rupees one lakh).

(a) If the offer from the above mentioned Co-operative Society is not below 80% of the recognized highest offer, the mahal shall be settled with such Co-operative Society at its own offer.

(b) Even, if the offer from the Co-operative Society is below 90% of the recognized highest offer, coupe or mahal may, at the discretion of the competent authority be settled with such Co-operative Society at an amount of 10 % less than the recognized highest offer.

(c) As between individual members of the categories mentioned in sub rule (i) above and a Co-operative Society mentioned in this sub rule the Co-operative Society shall be given preference over the individuals.

(3) No preferential treatment and concession as mentioned in (1) and (2) above shall be admissible when the recognized highest offer for the mahal exceeds Rs. 1,00,000.00/- (Rupees one lakh).

5. No Mahal will be settled jointly with more than one person except in the case of a Co-operative Society or a firm or a joint stock company duly registered in the office of the appropriate registering authority in Meghalaya.

6. The authority making the settlement will have the discretion to refuse settlement with a tender who though otherwise suitable is a defaulter in respect of any forest revenue in any forest division in Meghalaya.

7. There is no obligation on the part of the authority making settlement to accept the highest or any tender or to assign any reason for rejecting any tender.

8. (a) Any tenderer wishing to represent against the order of settlement may file an appeal petition (in duplicate) directly to the appropriate appellate authority as indicated below within 15(fifteen)days from the date of issue of the settlement order, affixing a court fee stamp of Rs.10/- (Ten) only on the Principal copy.

(b) (i) The Chief Conservator of Forests, Meghalaya, Shillong, against the order of settlement passed by the Divisional Forest Officer, the Chief Conservator of Forests appellate order shall be penal.

(ii) The Governor of Meghalaya against the order of the settlement passed by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Meghalaya, Shillong, the Governor's appellate shall be penal.

(c) Where the final order of settlement has been passed by the Governor of Meghalaya and tenderer willing to represent against such order may file directly to the Governor of Meghalaya within 15 (fifteen) days of settlement order a petition for review (in duplicate) affixing a court fee stamp of Rs. 10/- (Ten) only on the Principal copy.

(d) A copy of such appeal or review petition shall be simultaneously sent by the applicant or the petitioner, as the case may be also to the Divisional Forest Officers concerned.

(e) On admission of the appeal or the review petition or the reviewing authority may at its discretion stay further operation of the order of settlement until further orders.

(f) Whenever information is received by the Divisional Forest Officer, Garo Hills Division an appeal submitted to an authority by an aggrieved party against such settlement order the settlement may be kept pending till the order is received from the appellate authority on the same or until further orders.

9.(1) The successful tenderer must make within 15 (fifteen) days of the issue of the final order if settlement a security deposit in shape of postal saving bank accounts or national saving account certificate or defence certificate duly pledging the amount in favour of the Divisional Forest Officer, Garo Hills Division.

(2) The amount of such security shall be at the following rates-

(i) Ten percent of the first Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees two thousand) only, of the amount at which mahal is settled subject to a minimum of Rs.100/-(Rupees one hundred) only.

(ii) Five percent on the amount in excess of the first of Rs.2000.00/- (Rupees two thousand) only subject to a minimum of Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred) only.

(3) If the successful tenderer is a person belonging to any of the Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes recognized by the State Government the amount security deposit mentioned in sub-clause (2) above shall be reduced by 50 %.

(4) The authority which passes settlement orders may in its discretion call for additional security which together with the ordinary security mentioned in sub-clause (2) and (3) will not exceed 25% of the total value at which the mahal is settled.

(5) On successful completion of the work and payment of all dues the security deposit will be released.

10. The amount at which the mahal is settled shall be paid in two equal installments, the first installment falling due on the same day on which the security deposit if required to be made and the second installment on or before 15th December, 2006.

11. The successful tenderer must sign an agreement within one week of the payment of the security mentioned in Clause 9 and the first installment of the bid value as mentioned in clause 10 above, thereupon the work order will be issued to him.

Agreement or any other law in force within the area covered by agreement whether committed by the mahaldar or person in his employee and that he will pay such penalty not exceeding Rs.50.00/- (fifty) as may be imposed by the Divisional Forest Officer, Garo Hills Division in each and every breach of the condition of the agreement which penalty shall be leviable from him, his heirs, representatives and assigns as a public demand and that for breach for any of the said condition of the agreement shall at the discretion of the Divisional Forest Officer be liable to be cancelled immediately and all phuljharu extracted in forest be confiscated to government.

(iii) If it is called upon to do so the mahaldar shall supply the requirements of phuljharu to the department at the rate fixed by the department.

(iv) That the mahaldar must make his own arrangements for extraction of phuljharu from the mahal. The department does not bid itself to come into any matter of interference in extraction routes.

(v) That the mahaldar will not be allowed to export phuljharu beyond the state unless and until local demand is made with.

(vi) The Divisional Forest Officer, Garo Hills Division reserves the right to stop working the mahal and also to cancel the mahal agreement if the work is not done according to his satisfaction.
