Subject :- Ban on Air Travel of Ministerial accompanying Ministers on tour.

No.FEM .18/88/Pt.II/14.—In supersession of this Department's O.M. No. FEM. 18/88/Pt./15, dated 2nd February, 2009; it is hereby clarified that all types of tours by Ministerial staff attached to Minister like UDAs',/LDAs',/Typist'/Grade IV are banned completely with immediate effect. However, this order will not apply to cases where UDA is attached to a Minister to perform the duty of a P.A. and also to Personal Assistant or Special Assistant attached to Chief Minister and Hon'ble Speaker Meghalaya Legislative Assembly, subject to the condition that the number of eligible staff accompanying the Chief Minister/Hon,ble Speaker on official tour should in no case exceed 1 (one).

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 6 OF LAND ACQUISITION ACT, 1984
ACT 1 OF 1894

The 22nd December, 2010

No. RDA.1/2009/54.— Whereas it appears to the Government of Meghalaya that land is required to be taken by Government at public expenses for the construction of Border Out Post in the villages of Hamenager, Kaithakona and Majhesora Sub-Division, Nongstoin, and Kakergora BOP, Mawkyrwat Sub-Division, West Khasi Hills District. It is hereby declared that land for the above purpose measuring more or less 6.41, 2.007 and 1.41 and 2.51 acres of standard measurement as per schedule of boundaries below :-

1. B.O.P at Hamenagar.

North : Land of Shri Rockersingh Syiem occupied by Shri Suklal Banai.
South : Moheshkhola - Balat Border Road.
East : Pangthal DWA Nala.
West : Land of Shri Rockersingh Syiem occupied by Shri Biswajit Banai.
Area : 6.41 acres.

No.2 B.O.P at Kaithakona.

North : Hahshah land of Hahshah Nongiriang clan

East : Hahshah Land of Hahshah Nongiriang clan occupied by Shri Subet Sangma.
West : Hahshah Land of Hahshah Nongiriang clan occupied by Shri Etwar Marak.
Area : 1.41 acres.

No.4 Kakergora B.O.P.

North : Land of Ojit Dey (Tenant).
South : Land of Kartik Marak.
East : Land of Smti. Rina Kharwar and Shri Kartik Marak.
West : Land of Kartik Marak.
Area : 2.51 acres.

Is required within the aforesaid villages of Nongstoin Sub-Division, West Khasi Hills District.

This Declaration is made under the provisions of Section 6 of Act I of 1894 which was amended by Act 68 of 1984, to all whom it may concern.

Site plan of the land may be inspected in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner/Collector, West Khasi Hills District, Nongstoin.

Nothing in this declaration will be considered to apply to land which resumable for the said purpose under the terms of the lease and which Government elect to resume instead of acquiring under the Act.

No.LBG-211/88/Pt.II/141 .— The following draft of certain rules further to amend the Meghalaya Inter State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 1985 here in referred to as principal Rules to make in exercise of power conferred by section 35 of the Inter State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1979 (Act No.30 of 1979) is hereby given that the said draft Rules will be taken into consideration by the Government after a period of 45 days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be reached from any person with respect to the said Rules, within the period specified above will be duly considered by the State Government.

1. Short title and commencement :

- (1) These rules may be called the Meghalaya Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) (Second Amendment) Rules, 2010.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment of Rule 12 — Fees :

In sub-rule (1) of rule 12 of the principal Rules, for the Figure and word “Re.1”, the figure and words “Rs.6.00 (Rupees six)” shall be substituted.

In sub-rule (2) of rule 12 of the principal Rules, for the Figure and word “Re.1”, the figure and words “Rs.6.00 (Rupees six)” shall be substituted.

3. Amendment of Rule 16 — Issue of Duplicate Certificate of Registration or Licence:

For the Figures and words “50.00, (Rupees fifty)” the figures and words “Rs.100.00 (Rupees one hundred)” shall be substituted.

4. Amendment of Rule 19 — Obtaining of copies of Ordeer:

For the Figures and words “25.00, (Rupees twenty five)”, the figures and words “Rs.50.00 (Rupees fifty)” shall be substituted.
