No.ERTS (E)1/2012/Pt/169. - In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 183(2)(d) of the Meghalaya Excise Rules 1945 (Assam Excise Rules, 1945 as adapted by Meghalaya), and in partial modification to Government Notification *vide* No.ERTS (E) 1/2012/643, dated 22nd November, 2017, the following areas are declared as liquor free area for a distance of minimum 50 meters from the edge of the road for Retail IMFL '**OFF**' and '**ON**' licenses.

(i)	Governor's House Point-State Central Library Point-Secretariat Road-Kachari Point-Governor's House Point.
(ii)	State Central Library Point-Barik Point-Civil Hospital Point-Monolith Point in front of State Central Library.

(iv)	Don Bosco Square Point to meeting point (4 th Furlong Bridge) of Polo Road <i>via</i> Shillong College - B. K. Bajoria School.
(v)	Shillong College to All India Radio Point <i>via</i> St. Anthony's College and also Jacob's Ladder Road and Hopkinson Road.
(vi)	Dhankheti Point to All India Radio Point <i>via</i> Loretto up.
(vii)	Raj Bhawan Round Road.
(viii)	Road from Pinewood junction to the Bridge going to Earl Sanatorium <i>via</i> Ward's Lake, Botanical Garden to Bivar Road and also Bishop's Cotton Road.
(ix)	Barik Police Point to Civil Hospital Point <i>via</i> Lady Hydari Park, Pine Mount School and Red Cross.
(x)	Fire Brigade Point <i>via</i> Bethany Hospital <i>via</i> both upper and lower Nongrim Hills Road upto Nongrim Hills petrol pump junction.

No.FE.471/2017/9. - In pursuance of clause (3) of Article 166 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to order that the following amendment shall be made to **Schedule IV** of the Meghalaya Delegation of Financial Powers Rules, 2006 namely:-

AMENDMENT NO. 16.

1. **Short title and commencement** - (1) These Rules may be called the Meghalaya Delegation of Financial Powers (Amendment) Rules, 2017.
(2) They shall come into force from the date of notification in the Official Gazette.
2. **Addition of new entries Sl. No. 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 in No. 18 of Schedule IV of the Meghalaya Delegation of Financial Powers Rules, 2006** - After Sl. No. 4 of the existing entries of Page 66 under the Meghalaya Administrative Training Institute (MATI), the following entries shall be added, namely,-

9.	Cost of Boarding & Lodging of Resource persons, participants in Guest House/Hotels etc. when required.	Director	Full power	Subject to budget provision/specific provision of fund.
