NOTIFICATION

BEFORE THE ONE MAN COMMISSION OF INQUIRY
HEADED BY JUSTICE T. VAIPHEI
(MUKROH INCIDENT)

The 9th December, 2022.

No.Inquiry.1/2022/1.-WHEREAS the Government of Meghalaya in the Home (Political) Department has issued the Notification No.POL.195/2022/7, dated 23rd November, 2022 constituting a One Man Commission of Inquiry headed by the undersigned under Section 3 of the Commission of Inquiry Act, 1952 (hereafter referred to as "the Act") to inquire into the death of six people for the following terms of reference:

1. To inquire into the circumstances leading to the firing by the Assam Police and Assam Forest officials on the 22nd November, 2022 resulting in the death of six people;
2. To give a fact finding report as to the culpability or otherwise of the action of the Assam Police and Assam Forest officials, which resulted in the death of six people;
3. Any other circumstances which, in the opinion of the Commission, are relevant.

The Commission in terms of the above Notification held its first sitting on 2nd December, 2022 at the Office building of the Meghalaya Human Rights Commission, Shillong with Mr. Ronnie Son Wahlang, MCS, as the Secretary to Commission and has taken the following decisions:

1. The Commission will have its office at the office building of the Meghalaya Human Rights Commission, Old Arunachal Pradesh Secretariat, Cantonment Area near Anjali Petrol Pump, Shillong-793001; all correspondences for the Commission shall be addressed to the Secretary to the Commission at the above address hereafter.
2. The Commission has authorized Mr. Ronnie Son Wahlang, Secretary to the Commission to receive all correspondences received from all concerned, place the same before the Commission and sign all correspondences, summons/notices including the orders passed by the Commission from time to time for and in the name of the Commission.

3. The Commission notices that no rules have been framed by the State Government under Section 12(1)(c) read with Section 12(4) of the Act to regulate the manner in which inquiries may be held under the Act in respect of the proceedings before it and in the absence thereof, the Commission hereby, *mutati mutandi*, adopts the provisions of the Commission of Inquiry (Central) Rules, 1972 (hereinafter referred to as "the Rules" for short) to regulate its proceedings. The Commission also, consistent with the Act and the Rules made thereunder, reserves its right to adopt such other procedures as may be necessary for the smooth functioning of its proceedings.
4. The Commission also notes that the Notification dated 23rd November, 2022 constituting the One Man Commission has mentioned that the venue of the inquiry shall be Shillong, which is contrary to the provisions of Section 8 of the Act, which says that the Commission shall, *subject to any rules that may be made in this behalf*, have the power to regulate its own procedure including the *fixing of places* and times of its sittings and deciding whether to sit in public or in private. As already noted, no such rules have been framed by the Government. Therefore, a corrigendum to that effect may be issued by the Home (Political) Department without delay.
5. Notices under Rule 5(2)(a) of the Rules are to be issued to the Director General of Police, Assam and the Principal Chief Conservator of Assam to furnish to the Commission a statement relating to the firing incident which took place on 22nd November, 2022 at Mukroh village, particularly, the particulars of the Assam Police officials and Assam Forest officials involved in that incident and of the facts and circumstances which resulted in the death of five persons from Meghalaya and one person from Assam. Such statements must be accompanied by a list of the documents, if any, which they propose to rely, together with the originals or true copies of such of the documents as may be in their respective possession or control and supported by an affidavit, which should reach the Commission on or before **29th December, 2022**. If such of the documents are not in their possession or control, they shall state the names and addresses of the persons from whom the remaining documents may be obtained. Steps to be taken by the Secretary within 3 (three) working days.
6. Notice is also to be issued to the Director General of Meghalaya to furnish, to the Commission, on or before **29th December, 2022**, a statement relating to the above incident, which should be supported by an affidavit together with a list of documents, if any, which he proposes to rely and the originals or true copies of such of the documents as may be in his possession or control and shall also state the names and addresses of the person or persons from whom the remaining documents may be obtained. Steps to be taken by the Secretary to the Commission within 3 (three) working days.
7. A public notice under Rule 5(1)(b) of the Rules is also being issued inviting all *persons* acquainted with the subject matter of the inquiry to furnish to the Commission a statement relating to the above incident, supported by affidavit, which should reach the Commission on or before **29th December, 2022**.

The public notice shall be published in *two prominent dailies* (one of which will be in vernacular) of Meghalaya and *two prominent dailies* of Assam (one of which will be in vernacular) without any delay.

The Secretary is to take necessary actions to get this Notification published in the Official Gazette of the Government of Meghalaya, Home (Political) Department apart from the actions which he is required to take as indicated above as early as possible.
