No.CEKSF.2/89/424. - Under Section 13(2) of the Meghalaya Co-operative Societies' Act, 2015, the amendments shown below in the Bye-Law of '**Shillong College Employees Mutual Benefit Fund and Consumers Co-operative Society Ltd.**' registered under the Meghalaya Co-operative Societies' Act, 2015 (Act No.11 of 2015) in the District of East Khasi Hills, Meghalaya, Shillong has duly registered.

The Bye-laws amended and registered this day **9th January Two Thousand Twenty Three** are as follows:-

Partial Amendment of Bye-Laws:

<p>Bye-Law No. 18(a)</p> <p>(i) (TO BE ADDED)</p> <p>(ii) (TO BE ADDED)</p>	<p>The Society shall receive monthly contributions from the members as per the following categories of employees of College:</p> <p>(i) A member belonging to the category of permanent non-teaching staff of Shillong College may contribute monthly a sum of ₹ 1000/- (Rupees one thousand) or ₹ 1500/- (Rupees one thousand five hundred) or ₹ 2000/- (Rupees two thousand) or ₹ 3000/- (Rupees three thousand) or ₹ 4000/- (Rupees four thousand) or ₹ 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) towards the thrift fund.</p> <p>(ii) A member belonging to the category of permanent teaching staff of Shillong College may contribute monthly a sum of ₹ 2000/- (Rupees two thousand) or ₹ 3000/- (Rupees three thousand) or ₹ 4000/- (Rupees four thousand) or ₹ 5000/- (Rupees five thousand) towards the thrift fund.</p>
<p>Bye-Law No. 34(i)</p>	<p>The maximum limit of loan sanctioned to individual member shall be fixed at ₹ 10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakhs) only per member under normal circumstances.</p>
<p>Bye-Law No. 34(ii)</p>	<p>In case of need for loan of higher amount in unusual circumstances, the maximum limit of the loan sanctioned to individual member shall be fixed at ₹ 12,00,000/- (Rupees twelve lakhs) only. An applicant for such a loan must possess to his/her credit the requisite number (300) of shares each valued ₹ 200/- Sanction of such loan is however subject to the condition laid down in the note below.</p> <p>NOTE:- Unusual circumstances include</p> <p>(a) Unchange</p> <p>(b) Unchange</p> <p>(c) Unchange</p> <p>(d) Unchange</p>
<p>Bye-Law No. 34(iii)</p>	<p>A fresh member of the Society who has not been confirmed in his/her post in the college service may apply for loan not exceeding ₹ 40,000/- (Rupees forty thousand) only after completing continuous and uninterrupted membership of the Society for at least 6 (six) months which must be refunded in maximum of 12 (twelve) equal monthly installments together with Interest.</p>

Bye-Law No. 34(iv)	A fresh member of the Society who has already been confirmed in his/her post in the college service and has completed at least 6 (six) months of continuous and uninterrupted membership of the Society but has not yet completed a least two years of membership shall be eligible to apply for loan not exceeding a sum of ₹ 80,000/- (Rupees eighty thousand) only which must be refunded in maximum of 24 (twenty four) equal monthly installments together with Interest.
Bye-Law No. 34(v)	A fresh member of the Society who has already been confirmed in his/her post in the college service and has completed continuous and uninterrupted membership of the Society but has not yet completed a least 3 (three) years, but has not yet completed at least 5 (five) years of membership shall be eligible to apply for loan not exceeding a sum of ₹ 1,20,000/- (Rupees one lakh twenty thousand) only, which must be refunded in maximum of 24 (twenty four) equal monthly installments together with Interest.
Bye-Law No. 34(vi)	Any confirmed employee of the college after remaining in college service continuous for a period of 5 (five) years or more and as a member of the Society continuously for at least 1 (one) year shall be eligible to apply for a loan under sub-clause (i) and (ii) of the clause 34 of the Bye-Laws. Sanction of the specified in the above sub-clause viz. 34(i), 34(ii) shall be the discretion of the Board of Directors after obtaining guarantee of two or more full time confirmed employee of the college and a member of the Society.
Bye-Law No.44 (f) (TO BE ADDED)	(f) After the declaration of Interest on thrift and dividend on paid-up share capital at the Annual General Meeting of the Society, a member of the Society may reinvest the Interest and Dividend towards his/her thrift fund.
