Roles & Responsibilities of the Restructured MBM.

The restructured Meghalaya Bamboo Mission (MegBaM) will have multiple functions in coordinating the development activities of the bamboo sector in the State. Stakeholders, including the CFC cooperatives/societies, farmer organisations, traders and financial institutions are envisioned to represent at the reconstituted State Level Executive Committee (SLEC). The enhanced roles and responsibilities are:

- I. Preparation and validation of project proposals; prepare perspective and annual State Level Action Plan and oversee its implementation in close coordination with the SLEC.
- II. Play the lead role in coordinating with government and non-government agencies concerning development of the bamboo sector in the State, viz. the Forest & Environment Department, Department of Industries & Commerce, Department of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Department of Tourism and agencies such as the Meghalaya Basin Development Agency (MBDA), and Meghalaya State Skill Development Society (MSSDS).
- III. Mobilize/Receive funds from the State Government and other sources for carrying out the Mission activities, maintain proper accounts thereof and submit Utilization Certificates to the concerned Agencies.
- IV. Release funds to the implementing organizations and oversee, monitor and review the implementation of programs.
- V. Implement and monitor the functioning of nurseries, agroforestry plantations, including proposed bamboo-based agroforestry plantations in mining wastelands.
- VI. Coordinate R&D projects in development of bamboo-based products and services in coordination with academic and research institutions, government institutes such as NECTAR, NESAC, NECBDC among others.
- VII. Work with financial, technical, and marketing stakeholders to address issues of access.
- VIII. Create and manage databases of skilled crafts persons/clusters, bamboo farmers/communities, and traders.
- IX. Develop and co-ordinate skilling and product design programmes/workshops/seminars; organise community-level awareness meetings.
- X. Provide information and promotional materials for press and social media release.

It shall be the endeavour of the Technical Agency to ensure that the roles and responsibilities of the restructured MegBaM is implemented in the State as per the approved Action Plan.

The post of Administrative Officer which is lying vacant shall be filled up temporarily from amongst the senior staff of the Directorate till a full-fledged AO is in place as per service rules. Other staff to be deployed from the Directorates accordingly for the smooth functioning of the Board. New posts may be created for other administrative positions at a later stage. Multi-tasking Assistants may be recruited on a contractual basis as and when required.

A. Immediate Scope of work of the Board:-

- (i) All matters as entrusted by the Cabinet Approval dated 15th November, 2022 which is to fill up the backlog vacancies in the Health & Family Welfare Department.
- (ii) The Board will set up systems in place while conducting the recruitment process which will be reviewed by the Government to consider making the board as a permanent board.

The Terms of Reference for the Board will be as follows:

- (i) To assess the requirement of all healthcare personnel including specialists, MBBS Doctors and other AYUSH Doctors and also the nurses on a continuous basis and to conduct recruitment accordingly.
- (ii) To conduct direct recruitment to various posts under the general and specialist stream within the purview of the Directorate of Health Services in a timely, simplified and streamlined manner to minimise the number of vacancies and to provide continuous health care services to the public.
- (iii) Recruitment will be held on a regular basis (bi-annually / annually) for various categories of posts under the Health & Family Welfare Department as per the vacancies that arise and due compliance with the existing Supreme Court Rulings will also be ensured.
- (iv) Filling up of backlog vacancies at the earliest.
- (v) Proactive recruitment of medical professionals based on projections, retirements, etc.

- (vi) Improvement of health care service delivery at all levels of the health system.
- (vii) The MMRB shall follow the best practices of recruitment to ensure effective and transparent process for recruitment for inducting competent medical personnel.

A. Powers and Function of the Meghalaya Medical Services Recruitment Board (MMRB):

- (i) To assess the number of vacancies (Sanctioned post - In-position) of Medical Officers posts on a Quarterly/bi-annual/annual basis in the system. The Board will strictly be for recruitment only under the Chairmanship of the Senior Civil Service Officers. Assessment should be done at the level of the Department only.
- (ii) To conduct an end-to-end recruitment process for identification of the number of vacancies for appointment of selected candidates.
- (iii) The Meghalaya Medical Services Recruitment Board (MMRB) will function independently from the Meghalaya Public Service Commission (MPSC). The MMRB will be responsible for recruitment of Medical Officers/Specialists under the Health and Family Welfare Department, Government of Meghalaya in the initial phase and subsequently will include the recruitment of all other categories relating to the Department. The board shall maintain State Reservation Policy for all recruitments and in compliance to the Order of the Hon'ble High Court to maintain the **roster system**.
- (iv) The supporting staff in the Health and Family Welfare Department involved in the recruitment at the Directorate level will be re-assigned to the Meghalaya Medical Recruitment Board (MMRB). They will continue to perform the same duties with additional responsibilities depending on the requirement of the recruitment process.
- (v) All members of the MMRB will be entrusted with the task to plan, supervise and to execute all recruitment process activities in the aforesaid recruitment board from time to time or as decided by the Board.
- (vi) The sanctioned posts of the Doctors/ Specialists already referred to the MPSC earlier by the Department will also be recalled and taken up by the MMRB with immediate effect.

B. Location:

The Meghalaya Medical Services Recruitment Board (MMRB) will be made functional with immediate effect with the infrastructure available attached with the Directorate of Health Services (MI), Red Hill Road, Upper New Colony, Shillong.

C. Sources of Funds:

- (i) The Meghalaya Medical Services Recruitment Board is to be funded by the State Government and shall submit yearly budget proposals as any other entity under the Government of Meghalaya.
- (ii) A separate budget head is to be created under the State Budget for the purpose of carrying out the functions of the Meghalaya Medical Services Recruitment Board.

The funds for the Recruitment Board will consist of the following:

For reimbursement of the expenditure, the Superintendent of the concerned Government hospital will submit details of the bills and bank account to Director of Health Services (MI) Meghalaya, Shillong as the case may be for verification, who will submit these to the State Nodal Health Officer for election. Health & Family Welfare Department for onward submission of the verified bills to Election Department along with recommendation for reimbursement of the fund to the concerned hospital account directly by the Election Department.
4. In case of any referral made by treating Hospital to another hospital outside the Health & Family Welfare Department, a report shall immediately be submitted by Superintendent of the Hospital to State Nodal Health Officer for election Health & Family Welfare Department, in the format given at Annexure-II. CEO, Election Department, Meghalaya will communicate in writing to the referral hospital to ensure cashless treatment for the referred patient as per Government norms and also inform that the expenditure in this connection shall be borne by the Election Department, Government of Meghalaya. The referral hospital will submit the bills to the CEO, who will in turn forward these to Director of Health Services (MI), Meghalaya, Shillong. The verified bills will be submitted by Director of Health Services (MI) to the State Nodal Health Officer for election, Health & Family Welfare Department for onward submission of the bills to Election Department along with recommendation for reimbursement of the fund to the concerned hospital directly by the Election Department.

11. Local Allowance The Officer will be entitled to the Local (City) allowance, House rent allowance and other local allowances according to the rules of the Foreign Employer/borrowing Government.
12. Bonus The Officer will be entitled to the Bonus if any, at the rate as declared and allowed by the Foreign Employer to its employees if she opts the scale of pay of the deputation post.
13. Leave Rules The Officer will remain subject to Leave Rules applicable to the Service of which she is a member.
14. Travelling Concession The Officer will be entitled to Leave Travel Concession from the Foreign Employer/borrowing Government on the scale she is entitled to under the Parent Government and the cost of such concession will be borne by the Foreign Employer/borrowing Government.
15. Residential Accommodation The Officer will be entitled to the residential accommodation according to the Rules of her parent Government (or the Rules of the Foreign Employer/borrowing Government according to her option to draw her own grade pay or the scale of pay of the deputation post) and the

expenditure should be borne by the Foreign Employer/borrowing Government.

16. Moveable &
Immoveable
Properties

The Officer will regularly furnish returns of Movable and Immoveable properties owned by her to her Parent Government.

17. Commencement &
Termination

The date of Commencement of the Service on deputation will be the date of Deputation Services of the Officer handed over charge of the post in her Parent Department/Office and the date of termination will be the date she takes over charges of the post in her Parent Department Office as provided under the Meghalaya Fundamental Rules & Subsidiary Rules, 1984.
