NOTIFICATIONS

The 24th March, 2023.

No.POWER-5/99/109. - In exercise of the powers conferred by Rule 7, Sub-rule (2) of the Indian Electricity Rules, 1956, and in supercession of Notification No.PE.5/99/34, dated 6th June, 2011, the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to prescribe the following scale of fees for testing and inspection and generally for the services of an Inspector of Electricity to the Government under the Indian Electricity Act, 2003 (Act 36 of 2003) and the said Rules.

1. This order shall come into force with immediate effect.
2. In this order, the terms and expressions used shall have the same meaning as they have in the Indian Electricity Act and the Indian Electricity Rules except for the purpose of this order:-
 - (a) "Owner" shall include an occupier of any building place carriage or vessel in which energy is, or is about to be, generated received or used.
 - (b) "Initial" with reference to the inspection, examination or test of any electrical installation or apparatus shall mean an inspection, examination or test made prior to the bringing in use of such installation or apparatus but shall include in the case of any installation in which energy is used at low medium or high pressure, the first inspection examination or test made of such installation or apparatus being brought into use if such installation or apparatus was not inspected, examined or tested by an Inspector of Electricity prior to its being brought into use.
 - (c) "Licensee" shall include a person engaged in the business or supplying energy with the sanction of the Appropriate Commission obtained under sanction 14 of the Indian Electricity Act, including the Meghalaya Energy Corporation Limited and any Generating Companies operating in the State.
3. Subject to the following conditions fees shall be levied for testing and inspection and generally for the services of an Inspector of Electricity under the Indian Electricity Act, 2003 and the Indian Electricity Rules, 1956 from the persons and in accordance with the scales specified in the schedule:-
 - (1) In the case of any inspection, examination or test specified in Scales A to D no fee shall be levied for a second or subsequent inspection, examination or test made within a period of twelve months from the date of a similar inspection, examination or test for which the prescribed fee has been paid unless such further inspection, examination or test is made on application or is necessary as the result of an extension or alternation of the installation or is the opinion of the Inspector of Electricity necessitated by a breach of any of the provisions of the Act or of the Rules there-under or by the neglect or failure of the licensee or owner to carry out within the stipulated time any written order of an Inspector of Electricity.

- (2) In the case of any inspection, examination or test specified in scales E to M no fee shall be levied for any inspection, examination or test unless:-
- (i) Such inspection, examination or test is made on application or (ii) it is established to the satisfaction of the Inspector of Electricity that the installation or apparatus inspected, examined or tested is not in accordance with the provisions of the Act or any rule there-Under.
4. For all inspections or tests made and services rendered by the Inspector of Electricity at the request of the owner of licensee the prescribed fees shall be charged for and paid in advance.
 5. Where the licensee or the owner reports that the installation is complete and ready for inspection, but during the inspection carried out on the basis of such report, it is found that installation is incomplete and that subsequent inspection is necessary, full fees shall be charged for each such subsequent inspection.
 6. Any addition at high pressure to an existing installation will be treated as a new installation and all such additions to high pressure installation shall be notified under Rule 63 by licensee and owner to the Inspector of Electricity.
 7. Except in the cases mentioned in clause 4, "the fees prescribed in the schedule will be demanded by a bill by the Inspector of Electricity after the inspection, examination or test has been completed and shall be paid within thirty days from the receipt of the bill, into Government treasury or the Reserve Bank of India in the State of Meghalaya under the head - 0043- Taxes & Duties on Electricity - Receipt under Electricity Rules" and Treasury receipt thereafter forwarded to the Inspector of Electricity to the Government.
 8. Failure to pay the fees demanded will render the owner or Licensee liable to action under section 146 of the Indian Electricity Act, 2003, under which the fee will be recovered on application to a magistrate having a jurisdiction by the distress and sale of any movable property belonging to the owner or Licensee.

Note:- (1). Under Scale J as to the effect of distances in making special visits difficult and expensive applies *mutatis mutandis* to tests or visits under of the Scheduled Scales.

	3) It is not recommended that meters be sent from distant towns. Even if found correct on arrival there is no guarantee they were correct when disconnected for transit for test nor that they will be correct when received again after test.
