1. **Short title and commencement:-** (1) These Rules may be called the Meghalaya State Food Commission (Amendment) Rules, 2023.

2. **Amendment to Rule 6.** - Rule 6 shall be read as:-

"Tenure of the Chairperson and Members- The Chairperson and every other Members shall hold office for a term not exceeding five years from the date on which he enters upon his office and shall be eligible for reappointment:

Provided that no person shall hold office as the Chairperson or other Member after he attained the age of sixty-five years."
