No.FEM(PC)82/2022/4. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Meghalaya Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules), namely-

THE MEGHALAYA CIVIL SERVICES (PENSION) (SIXTH AMENDMENT) RULES, 2023.

1. **Short title and commencement:-** (1) These rules may be called the Meghalaya Civil Services (Pension) (Sixth Amendment) Rules, 2023.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 2017.

2. **Amendment of Rule 39:-** In Rule 39 of the Principal Rules, sub rule (2) shall be substituted by the following:-

"(2) (a) - In the case of a Government servant retiring in accordance with the provisions of these rules after completing qualifying service of not less than 30 (thirty) years, pension shall be paid @ 50% of the last pay drawn or @ 50% of the last six-month's average emoluments of the employee, whichever is more beneficial to the pensioner, subject to the maximum of ₹ 75,850.00 (Rupees Seventy five thousand eight hundred fifty) per mensem.

(b) - In the case of a Government servant retiring in accordance with the provisions of these rules before completing qualifying service of 30 (thirty) years, but after completing qualifying service of 10 (ten) years or more, the amount of pension shall be proportionate to the amount admissible under Clause (a) and in no case the amount of pension shall be less than ₹ 8,700.00 (Rupees eight thousand seven hundred only) per month (excluding the element of additional pension to old pensioners/family pension holders).

Note - The term "emoluments" for the purpose of calculation/computation of various pensionary benefits, other than various kinds of gratuity, shall have the same meaning as in Rule 28 of the Rule."

3. **Amendment of Rule 39A:-** In Rule 39 of the Principal Rules, after sub-rule (2) new sub-rule (3) shall be inserted as follows,-

"(3) Dearness Relief will be admissible on the additional pension available to the old pensioners."

4. **Amendment of Rule 40:-** In proviso to Rule 40 of the principal Rules, the existing figures of "₹ 7,00,000.00" shall be substituted by "₹10,00,000.00."

5. **Amendment of Rule 46:-** In rule 46 of the principal Rule, the existing sub-rule (1) shall be substituted by the following:-

"(1). The monthly family pension is based on the "pay" drawn on the date of death or on the date of retirement, as the case may be, of the Government servant, it shall be calculated at a uniform rate of 30% of basic pay in all cases and shall be subject to a minimum of ₹ 8,700.00 per month."

6. **Amendment of Rule 46A:-** In rule 46 A of the principal Rules, after sub-rule (2), new sub-rule (3) shall be inserted as follows,-

"(3) Dearness Relief will be admissible on the additional pension available to the old family pensioners."

No.POWER-127/94/559. - In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub - Section (1) of Section 162 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003), the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to appoint the Executive Engineers of the Meghalaya Power Distribution Corporation Limited (MePDCL) to perform the function of Electrical Inspectors as specified in Rule 63 of the Indian Electricity Rules, 1956 in respect of energisation of Distribution Transformers, 11 KV lines and LT lines under **JAL JEEVAN MISSION** schemes of the Central Government in Meghalaya to expedite the works of completed lines and Sub- station within the respective Districts/Circles shown against their Divisions and with the following restrictions, due to present shortage of Electrical Inspectors in the state and time limitations to complete the schemes in scheduled time:

1. The above arrangement is made purely on temporary basis in respect of only the new installation works under **JAL JEEVAN MISSION** schemes as specified above and will cease to have its currency as soon as the works under the said scheme are over or as and when the Government revoke this arrangement in part or as a whole, whichever is earlier;
2. Approvals accorded under this arrangement are to be intimated to the Senior Electrical Inspector of the State of Meghalaya, along with relevant test report only for record purposes;
3. The functions of Electrical Inspectors for the purpose of Rule 63 of the Indian Electricity Rules, 1956 shall not be exercised in any other cases excepting in those specified above.
4. This delegation of statutory powers of Electrical Inspectors is not a corporate delegation and as such holding charge of any post or position by any other persons in place of the following duly qualified Executive Engineers shall not entitle any person to function under this temporary arrangement unless the Government specifically notify in each case.

1. The amount of security deposit payable shall be the monthly average of the immediate last 12 (twelve) months of tax assessed or admitted tax paid whichever is higher and to be determined by the jurisdictional Superintendent of Taxes.
2. The amount of security deposit payable shall be deposited and a copy of the Treasury Challan or GRAS receipt evidencing payment of the security deposit shall be furnished to the jurisdictional Superintendent of Taxes by the 7th (seventh) day of the month of the relevant tax period.
3. Terms & conditions

- 1. Period of Deputation** With effect from 1st November, 2022 to 13th December 2022 (A/N) with deputation allowance/without deputation allowance.
- 2. Pay** During the period of deputation, the Officer will be entitled to draw his own grade Pay and Allowances as admissible under State Govt. Rules plus Deputation (duty) Allowance as laid down in the O.M.No.FEG.9/2018/15 dated 7th March 2018 (copy enclosed).
- 3. Dearness Allowances etc.** The Officer will be entitled to the Dearness Allowances under the rules of his parent Government or under the rules of Foreign Employer/borrowing Government according to his option to retain his scale of pay under the Parent Government or he draws pay in the scale of pay attached of the post under the Foreign Employer/borrowing Government.
- 4. Joining time T.A/D.A.** The Officer will be entitled to joining time and T.A/D.A both on joining the post of deputation and on reversion there from to the parent Department Government under the rules of the Foreign Employer.
