**No.DC/L/VII/3/2019-2023/26/247.** – In pursuance of Paragraph 11 of the Sixth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the following Amendment Act of the Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council is hereby published for general information:-.

**THE KHASI HILLS AUTONOMOUS DISTRICT (NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF THE SYIEM, DEPUTY SYIEM AND ELECTORS OF HIMA MAHARAM) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2019.**

*(Passed by the Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council on the 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2019)*

*(Received the assent of the Governor on 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2023)*

*(Published in the Gazette of Meghalaya Extraordinary issue dated 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2023)*

**AN**

**ACT**

to further amend the Khasi Hills Autonomous District (Nomination and Election of the Syiem, Deputy Syiem and Electors of Hima Maharam) Act, 2006.

It is hereby enacted by the Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council in the Sixty Ninth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

**1. Short title, Extent and Commencement –**

- (1) This Act may be called the Khasi Hills Autonomous District (Nomination and Election of the Syiem, Deputy Syiem and Electors of Hima Maharam) (Amendment) Act, 2019.
  - (2) It shall extend to the whole of Hima Maharam.
  - (3) It shall come into force as the Executive Committee, Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council may by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.
2. In the Principal Act, in Section 2, after clause 'j', the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided that in Raid Sawsymer, the Myntri shall also be known as Rangbah Shnong (Headman)."
3. In the Principal Act, in Section 8, after sub-section 3, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided that in Raid Sawsymer, where a vacancy in the post of Myntri or Headman occurs, it shall be reported to the Syiem and his Dorbar with the recommendation from the Dorbar Raid and the meeting for the election shall be presided over by the Syiem or by any person authorised by him, in the presence of the representative of the Dorbar Raid who will jointly declare the election result. Further, the term of Office of a Myntri or Rangbah Shnong (Headman) is fixed for a period of three years from the date of issue of the Sanad."

**STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

Whereas, it has become expedient to further amend this Act to include Raid Sawsympet within the ambit and scope of the Maharam Act in compliance with the Agreement of 1944 signed by the elders of Raid Sawsympet which was duly confirmed by the Syiem of Maharam, Maharam Syiemship.

Hence, this Amendment Act.



**No.ERTS (T) 24/2023/12.** - In supersession of Government notifications No.ERTS (T) 24/2023/8, dated 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2023 and No.ERTS (T) 24/2023/Pt/5, dated 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2023 and in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 3 read with sub-section (2) of Section 3A of the Meghalaya (Sales of Petroleum products including Motor Spirit) Taxation Act, (Assam Act IX of 1956 as adapted and amended by Meghalaya), the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to modify and revise the rate of tax on Goods specified in the table below and to further specify that the rate of tax and pollution surcharge as indicated below will come into force with effect from 00.00 hrs. of 23<sup>rd</sup> September, 2023, and until further Orders.

**SCHEDULE**

Sl. No.	Description	Rate of Tax	Pollution Surcharge under sub-section (2) of Section 3A
1.	Motor Spirit (except diesel oil and other internal combustion oils other than petrol).	13.5% or ₹ 13.50/- (Rupees thirteen and paise fifty) only per litre whichever is higher.	Pollution surcharge of 10 (ten) paise per litre.
2.	Diesel oil and other internal combustion oils.	5% or ₹ 7.00/- (Rupees seven) only per litre whichever is higher.	Pollution surcharge of 10 (ten) paise per litre.
