- 1) The Monitoring Committee shall monitor the compliance of the provisions contained in the Central Government notification S.O.2877(E), dated 3rd July, 2023.
- 2) The tenure of the Monitoring Committee shall be three years or till it is reconstituted by the State Government, and after the expiry of the tenure of the Monitoring Committee, the subsequent Monitoring Committee shall be reconstituted by the State Government in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 5(1) of the above notification.
- 3) The Monitoring Committee shall, base on the actual site-specific conditions, scrutinise the activities that are covered in the Schedule to the notification of the Government of India in the erstwhile Ministry of Environment and Forest number S.O. 1553 (E), dated the 14th September, 2006, and are falling in the Eco-sensitive Zone, except for the prohibited activities as specified in the Table under paragraph 4 of the above notification and refer to the Central Government in the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, as the case may be, for prior environmental clearances under the provisions of the said notification.

- 4) The activities not covered in the Schedule to the notification of the Government of India in the erst-while Ministry of Environment and Forests number S.O. 1533 (E), dated the 14th September, 2006 and falling in the Eco-Sensitive Zone, except for the prohibited activities as specified in the Table under paragraph 4 of the above notification, shall be scrutinized by the Monitoring Committee based on the actual site-specific conditions and referred to the Regulatory Authorities concerned.
- 5) The Member-Secretary of the Monitoring Committee or the Collector concerned or the Deputy Conservator of Forests concerned shall be competent to file complaints under section 19 of the Environment Act against any person who contravenes the provisions of this notification.
- 6) The Monitoring Committee may invite representatives or experts from Departments concerned, representatives from industry associations or concerned stakeholders to assist in its deliberations depending on the requirements on issue to issue basis.
- 7) The Monitoring Committee shall submit the annual action taken report of its activities as on the 31st March of every year by the 30th June of that year to the Chief Wildlife Warden of the State in the Proforma at Annexure-V of the above notification.
- 8) The Central Government in the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may give such directions, as it deems fit, to the Monitoring Committee for effective discharge of its functions.
