#### OFFICE MEMORANDUM

**No.FEM.18/88/Pt.III/58.** - In supersession of this Department O.M.No.FEM.73/75/150, dated 17<sup>th</sup> November, 1988 and in clarification regarding doubts on the claim of Daily Allowance/incidental charge of Government Employee while performing journey on official duty within the State and outside the State but within the North Eastern Region, it is hereby clarified as under:

1. When a Government servant on tour to any place outside Meghalaya but within the North Eastern Region, returns to Headquarter on the same day where the total journey performed by road is not less than 80 Kms he shall be entitled to one incidental charge equivalent to normal Daily Allowance as on tour within the State. However, if the total journey is less than 80 Kms but more than 40 Kms on condition that the journey performed is not less than 6 hours, entitlement shall be  $\frac{1}{2}$  incidental charge equivalent to  $\frac{1}{2}$  Daily Allowance for such journey performed.
2. When a Government servant on tour returns to Headquarter from places outside Meghalaya but within the North Eastern Region, the following day after a night halt at such places where the total journey performed is not less than 80 Kms he shall be entitled to one incidental charge equivalent to normal Daily Allowance as on tour within the State in addition to normal Daily Allowance for halting at the rate of which is applicable to places outside the State but within North Eastern Region. Where the total journey performed is less than 80 Kms but more than 40 Kms  $\frac{1}{2}$  incidental charge equivalent to  $\frac{1}{2}$  Daily Allowance is admissible for such journey on tour.

This O.M shall take effect from the date of issue.
