Powers and Functions of the Juvenile Justice Boards as laid down under Section 8 of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children), Act 2015.

- i. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force but save as otherwise expressly provided in this Act, the Board constituted for any district shall have the power to deal exclusively with all the proceedings under this Act, relating to children in conflict with law, in the area of the jurisdiction of such Board.
- ii. The powers conferred on the Board by or under this Act may also be exercise by the High Court and the Children's Court, when the proceedings come before them under section 19 or in appeal, revision or otherwise,
- iii. The functions and responsibilities of the Board shall include:-

- ◆ Ensuring the informed participation of the child and the parent or guardian, in every step of the process.
- ◆ Ensuring that the child's rights are protected throughout the process of apprehending the child, inquiry, aftercare and rehabilitation.
- ◆ Ensuring availability of legal aid to the child through the legal services institutions.
- ◆ Wherever necessary the Board shall provide an interpreter or translator, having such qualification, experience and on payments of such fees as may be prescribed to the child if he fails to understand the language used in the proceedings.
- ◆ Directing the Probation Officer or in case a Probation Officer is not available to the Child Welfare Officer or a Social Worker, to undertake a social investigation in to the case and submit report within a period of fifteen days from the date of first production before the Board to ascertain the circumstances in which the alleged offence was committed.
- ◆ Adjudicate and dispose of cases of children in conflict with law in accordance with the process of inquiry specified in section 14.
- ◆ Transferring to the Child Welfare Committee matters concerning the child alleged to be in conflict with law stated to be in need of child and protection at any stage, thereby recognizing that a child in conflict with law can also be a child in need of care and protection simultaneously and there is a need for the committee and the Board to be both involved.
- ◆ Disposing of the matter and passing a final order that includes an individual care plan for the child's rehabilitation, including follow up by the probation or the District Child Protection Unit or a member of a non-governmental organisation, as may be required.
- ◆ Conducting inquiry for declaring fit persons regarding care of children in conflict with law.
- ◆ Conducting at least one inspection visit every month of residential facilities for children in conflict with law and recommend action for improvement in quality of services to the District Child Protection Unit and the State Government.
- ◆ Order the Police for registration of First information report for offences committed against any child in conflict with law, under this Act or any other law for the time being in force, on complaint made in this regard.

- ◆ Conducting regular inspection of jails meant for adults to check if any child is lodged in such jails and take immediate measures for transfer of such child to the observation home; and
- ◆ Any other function as may be prescribed.

2. The Committee shall function as a Bench of Magistrates and shall have the powers conferred by the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 on a Judicial Magistrate of the first class.
3. The Committee shall meet at such times and shall observe such rules of procedure in regard to the transaction of business at its meeting as may be prescribed.
4. A child in need of care and protection may be produced before a Chairperson/Individual Member for being placed in safe custody or otherwise when the Committee is not in session.
5. The Committee shall have the final authority to dispose of cases for the care, protection, treatment, development and rehabilitation of the children as well as to provide for their basic needs and protection of human rights.
6. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law for the time being in force but save as otherwise expressly provide in this Act, the Committee shall have the power to deal exclusively with all proceedings under the Act relating to children in need of care and protection.

7. The Committee shall hold its sitting in a child friendly premises which shall not look like a Court room in any manner and the sitting arrangement should be such to enable the committee to interact with the child face to face.
8. The committee shall submit a quarterly report on the nature or disposal of cases and pendency of cases to the District Magistrate in the manner as may be prescribed in the Form 16, for review of pendency of cases.
9. The District Magistrate shall be the grievances redressal authority for the Child Welfare Committee and any one aggrieved by the Child Welfare Committee's decision, may file a review petition before a District Magistrate, who shall review and pass appropriate order.

Tenure

The Committee shall have a term of 3 (three) years with effect from the date of issue of notification and the appointment of members shall be co-terminus with the tenure of the Committee.
