NOTIFICATION

No.464/EPS/2024(1). - WHEREAS, the President of India has, by notification issued under sub-section (2) of Section 14 of the Representation of People Act, 1951 (43 of 1951) and published in the Gazette of India on the 20th March, 2024 (Wednesday), been pleased to call upon each of the Parliamentary Constituencies, specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, in the States or Union Territories mentioned in column (1), of the Schedule to elect members to the House of the People, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act and of the rules and orders made thereunder;

2. **Now, therefore**, in pursuance of Sections 30 and 56 of the said Act, the Election Commission of India hereby-

(A) **Appoints**, with respect to the said election, from each of the parliamentary constituencies specified in the said Schedule,

(a) **the 28th March, 2024 (Thursday)**, as the last date for making nominations **for Bihar** and **the 27th March, 2024 (Wednesday)**, as the last date for making nomination **for Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, West Bengal, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Jammu and Kashmir, Lakshadweep and Puducherry;**

(b) **the 30th March, 2024 (Saturday)**, as the date for scrutiny of nominations **for Bihar** and **the 28th March, 2024 (Thursday)**, for scrutiny of nominations **for Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, West Bengal, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Jammu and Kashmir, Lakshadweep and Puducherry;**

(c) **the 02nd April, 2024 (Tuesday)**, as the last date for withdrawal of candidatures **for Bihar** and **the 30th March, 2024 (Saturday)**, as the last date for withdrawal of candidatures **for Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, West Bengal, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Jammu and Kashmir, Lakshadweep and Puducherry;**

(d) the date specified in column (3) of the **SCHEDULE** below, as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken in the parliamentary constituencies, specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of the said Schedule; and

(e) **the 06th June, 2024 (Thursday)**, as the date before which the election shall be completed in all the above mentioned parliamentary constituencies; and

(B) **Fixes the hours** specified in column (4) of the said Schedule, as the hours during which the poll shall, if necessary, be taken in the constituencies, specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) of the said Schedule, on the date specified against such constituency in column (3) thereof, for the above election.

Whereas, the Election Commission has considered the circumstances in all the Parliamentary Constituencies of Lok Sabha, all the Assembly Constituencies of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Odisha & Sikkim at the current general elections, 2024 and in 26 Assembly Constituencies (as per Annexure-1) in 13 States at the current bye-elections, announced *vide* the Election Commission's Press Notes No.ECI/PN/23/2024 & ECI/PN/24/2024, both dated 16th March, 2024, and is satisfied that sufficient number of Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) and Printers for printing Paper Trail [Voter Verifiable Paper Audit Trail (VVPAT)] are available for taking the poll in all the Parliamentary Constituencies and all the Assembly Constituencies of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Odisha and Sikkim and in 26 Assembly Constituencies (as per Annexure-1) of 13 States. The polling personnel are well trained in efficient handling of EVMs and 'VVPAT Printers' and the electors are also fully conversant with the operation of the EVMs and the VVPAT Printers;
 4.
