- Since the area is falling under Wildlife area there should not be hindrance for the movement of animals and night vision signboard should be

erected by the User Agency for the crossing zones.

- To reduce the speed, rumble strips should be constructed at the vulnerable areas.
- The user agency should not dump the excess earth cutting into the Kanai River as it may affect the flow.
- The labour camps should not be set up within the BNP area and they will carry out the work from outside the BNP area. The user agency should construct within the ROW (within the prescribed limit).
- The User Agency shall implement the animal passage plan prepared in accordance with the guidance document, 'Eco-friendly measures to mitigate the impacts of linear infrastructures on wildlife'.
- An annual compliance certificate on the stipulated conditions shall be submitted by the User Agency to the State Chief Wild Life Warden and an annual compliance certificate shall be submitted by the State Chief Wild Life Warden to the Government of India.
