GOVERNMENT OF MEGHALAYA NOTIFICATIONS

The 23rd August, 2024.

No.Housing.11/2015/545.- The Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to notify the Voluntary Retirement Scheme to the employees of the Meghalaya State Housing Board.

Comment and Operation:-

I. Short title.—

- The Scheme shall be called as " Voluntary Retirement Scheme of 2024 of the Meghalaya State Housing Board."
- The Scheme shall come into force immediately and remain operative till such time or period that the Management may consider necessary subject to maximum of 180 days.

II. Extent of the Scheme.- No employees are excluded from coverage of this scheme, save and except as provided herein under:

- If the Housing Commissioner is satisfied that a particular employee/worker has become ineffective due to ill-health he/she shall have the absolute right to refer to such an employee to a Medical Board (to be constituted by the Housing Commissioner) in any of the following circumstances. Thereafter, the Housing Commissioner shall take the decision to effect premature retirement based upon the certificate of the Medical Board.
- When an employee /worker attending duties is found to be deranged or suffering from lunacy or mental infirmity and whose services the Board cannot utilize.
- When an employee/worker is suffering from a curable disease but is not likely to be fit to resume his/her normal duties within a period of 12 months.

- d) When an employee/worker is suffering from incurable and infectious disease and his/her attendance is likely to pose health hazards to others.
- e) When an employee/worker owing to physical or mental infirmity or deterioration in general health is unable to effectively discharge his/her duties.
- f) This scheme will not apply to employees/workers against whom disciplinary proceedings or prosecution in a criminal Court is pending or contemplated.

III. Definition.-- In this scheme unless the context or otherwise requires:-

- a) "Employee/worker" means a person who is in regular employment of the Meghalaya State Housing Board.
- b) "Medical Board" means a Medical Board constituted by the Housing Commissioner under the scheme comprising of not less than two qualified doctors who are specialists in their respective fields.
- c) " M.S.H.B." means Meghalaya State Housing Board.
- d) " Pay and Allowances " means basic pay, dearness allowance and additional dearness allowance as admissible immediately preceding the date of separation from service under the scheme.
- e) "Scheme" means the Voluntary Retirement Scheme of the Meghalaya State Housing Board.

IV. BENEFITS.- The following monetary benefits would be available to employees/workers seeking retirement under this scheme:

- a) **Lumpsum Compensation:** An employee/worker opting for the Voluntary Retirement Scheme would be entitled to a compensation equivalent to 2 months pay (basic pay plus DA) for each completed year of past service or the monthly pay and allowances at the time of retirement multiplied by the balance month of service left before normal date of retirement subject to a maximum of 48 months, whichever is less. For example, if an employee/worker who has put in 24 years of service and has got only one year of service left for normal retirement, he will get compensation of 12 months pay and allowances and not for 48 months.
- b) **Provident Fund:** Full employer's contribution to Provident as permissible under the Act.
- c) **Encashment of Earned Leave :** As per Rules applicable to the employees/ workers of the Meghalaya State Housing Board.
- d) **Payment of DCRG:** As per Rules applicable /admissible to the employees/workers of the Meghalaya State Housing Board.

V. Sanctioning Authority.--

- a) Notwithstanding anything contained in this scheme the Housing Commissioner shall be the Competent Authority to accept request for Voluntary Retirement Scheme.
- b) Notwithstanding anything contained in this scheme the Housing Commissioner shall be fully empowered either to accept or reject any request by any employee/ worker in the overall interest of MSHB.
- c) The decision of the Housing Commissioner in this regard shall be final.

VI. General.—

- a) The present scheme is independent of and without prejudice to the rights of Meghalaya State Housing Board to dispense with the services of the employees/ workers either under the Standing Orders/Disciplinary Rules as may be applicable to the employees.
- b) Payment under the scheme is subject to the recovery of amounts due to Meghalaya State Housing Board
- c) The scheme or benefits thereunder shall be deemed to be a matter of right or contract of term/condition of employment.
- d) The scheme and/ or the benefits thereunder are liable to be withdrawn in toto or in part at the sole discretion of MSHB without any notice and without assigning any reasons thereof.
- e) The MSHB also reserves its rights to alter and or amend any or all the terms and/ or conditions prescribed for the scheme.
- f) The Income Tax liability in respect of the benefits under the scheme shall be entirely that of the employees concerned.
- g) The posts falling vacant as a result of the employees/workers opting for V.R.S. shall be treated as finally abolished and no new similar posts shall be created.

In case of any doubt regarding interpretation of this scheme, the decision of the Government shall be final.

No. 593/2017(WP (CIVIL) No.375/2012), Paryavaran Surksha Samiti Vs Union of India & Ors. has unambiguously directed State & Central boards to levy Environmental Compensation on violators of environmental laws. The NGT Order on the matter is as follows: **"The CPCB may take penal action for failure, if any, against those accountable for setting up and maintaining STPs, CETPs and ETPs. CPCB may also assess and recover compensation for damage to the environment and said fund may be kept in a separate account and utilized in terms of an action plan for protection of the environment."**

Whereas, in the 63rd Conference of Chairman and Member Secretary of PCBs/Committees held on 18th March, 2019, it was decided that SPCBs/PCCs may frame their guidelines on Environmental Compensation based on "Report of the CPCB In-House Committee on Methodology for Assessing Environmental Compensation and Action Plan for utilization of the Environmental Compensation Fund.

Whereas in pursuance to the decision above, the Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board, prepared guidelines for assessing Environmental Compensation and Action Plan for utilization of the aforesaid fund and approved the draft Guidelines for Utilization of Environmental Compensation Fund *vide* Resolution No. 2.13 in its meeting held on 1st December, 2023.

Now therefore in compliance of the directions issued by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) and on recommendation of the Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board, the Guidelines for Utilization of Environmental Compensation Fund appended to this notification shall be in accordance and shall be effective with immediate effect until further orders.

Guidelines for Utilization of Environmental Compensation Fund

1.0 BACKGROUND

(CIVIL) No. 375/2012), Paryavaran Suraksha Samiti & Anr. Vs. Union of India & Ors has unambiguously directed State & Central Boards to levy Environmental Compensation on violators of Environmental laws.

The NGT Order on the matter is as follows: "**The CPCB may take penal action for failure, if any, against those accountable for setting up and maintaining STPs, CETPs and ETPs. CPCB may also assess and recover compensation for damage to the environment and said fund may be kept in a separate account and utilized in terms of an action plan for protection of the environment.**"

1. SCOPE OF ASSISTANCE:

- a. Scope of activities specified in the NGT Orders dated 22nd January, 2019 in OA no 101/2019 which is as listed below:
 - i. Development of infrastructure for Air and Water quality surveillance and monitoring for different areas/locations including field staff quarters in Meghalaya.
 - ii. Remediation of contaminated sites-and for that to develop infrastructure, procurement of equipment, etc. including hiring of Experts/ Consultants for specific requirement for remediation of sites, etc.
 - iii. Specific investigations and studies with regard to environment and ecology.
 - iv. Carrying capacity assessment for ecologically and environmentally sensitive & critical areas, including hiring of Experts/Consultants for specific purpose and period.
 - v. R & D activities with regard to new technologies, clean technologies, etc.
 - vi. Capacity building of scientific and engineering personnel of Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board to rejuvenate and protect the environment.
 - vii. Augmenting and strengthening of laboratory and engineering network in terms of manpower and logistics.
 - viii. Payment of honorarium in compliance of Judicial Orders of the Courts and Tribunal.
 - ix. Specialized studies on accidental spill areas, health impact assessment, recalcitrant pollutants, etc.
 - x. Information, Education and Communication (IEC) activities.
 - xi. Any other scientific and technical matter which may arise as a contingent matter.
 - xii. Conducting awareness (IEC) pertaining to Air, water, environment, Ecology.
 - xiii. Purchase of vehicle for field officers for monitoring purposes to check illegalities and impose EC.

- b. EC fund shall support activities like procurement of equipment, upgradation/establishment of laboratory, technical studies, survey and training of staff. However, the following areas shall be accorded priority for allocation of EC funds :
- i. Studies directed by Hon'ble NGT.
 - ii. R&D Activities for pollution control.
 - iii. Development of infrastructure for Water and Air Quality Surveillance.
 - iv. Strengthening and Upgradation of Laboratory.
 - v. Inventorization of sources of pollution.
 - vi. Preparation of DPR for remediation of contaminated sites.
 - vii. Capacity building of SPCB staff (Engineering & Scientific).
 - viii. Mass awareness programmes.
 - ix. Setting up of Model Sewage Treatment Plants/ Effluent Treatment Plants in government premises.
 - x. Erection of Signages with prohibitory orders all along the Rivers.
- c. Grant for salary support shall be restricted to scientific and technical project staff and would be limited to the project duration only.
- d. EC Fund shall not be sanctioned for land acquisition.
- e. No recurring expenditure shall be sanctioned under the EC Fund.

2. MODE OF PROPOSAL

Norms for receiving, processing, sanctioning of proposals shall be followed for efficient utilization of EC Funds. These norms are as given below:

- a. Depending upon the need, proposals may be invited by the Board from "Autonomous Institutions / Statutory Bodies under the Central / State Government" having domain expertise. Selection among the proposals received in response will be on the basis of technical soundness, including credentials of the grantee organization, team involved and cost effectiveness.
- b. The project works executed through "Autonomous Institutions/ Statutory Bodies under the Central / State Government", proper procedures shall be followed. The concerned Boards shall be solely responsible for following the procedure in procurement and awarding the works. The R&D Project works should not contain more than 50% of the amount for new equipment/instruments, if the work is awarded to outside

institutes. Equipment/ instruments procured under R&D projects shall be the property of concerned SPCB.

- c. The institutes shall submit the proposal as per the format enclosed for Utilization of EC funds. The proposal should clearly identify the objectives, activities, and methodology as well as project deliverables. It should also specify the additional personnel support required and the time-frame for overall execution of the project and timeline for associated project activities. Further, detailed cost breakup consistent with the funding norms shall be provided. The copy of format for utilization is annexed herewith as at ANNEXURE-I.

3. PROCEDURE FOR APPRAISAL OF PROPOSALS

A Committee is to be constituted by Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board comprising of the following members:

3.1 MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE:

- a. The committee shall meet at twice in a year (Once in six months) or as decided by the Chairperson.
- b. The quorum for such meeting shall be half of the total members of the Committee.

3.2 Powers & Functions of the Committee: The committee shall have the following powers and functions:

- a. Assessment of administrative feasibility and prioritization of various activities to be undertaken from the Environment Compensation fund.
- b. Determine project area for undertaking various activities and schemes under the Environment Compensation fund.
- c. Placing the Annual Action Plan before the Board for approval.

- d. Ensuring inter departmental coordination.
- e. Appointment of auditors for auditing accounts spent under Environment Compensation fund.
- f. Monitor the progress of the utilization of Environment Compensation fund and review progress of projects.

4. TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SANCTION OF PROPOSALS

- a. A project will normally be sanctioned for a fixed duration and a maximum of two years.
- b. Extension of project duration may be granted only in exceptional cases, subject to a maximum period of six months.
- c. Fund shall be spent by the Board as per provisions of State Financial Rules. The funds have to be audited as per statutory provisions.
- d. The implementing agencies/organizations/institutions /statutory bodies shall submit signed Utilization Certificate to the Member Secretary of the Board, which should also certify that the amount spent on the Project has been audited as per statutory requirements.
- e. The sanctioned proposals will become operative with effect from the date of receipt of work order.
- f. Cost over runs-if any, shall be borne exclusively by the concerned State Board.

5. MONITORING MECHANISM

- a) The Committee shall monitor progress of approved project /activities every four months or earlier, if necessary.
- b) The Committee may terminate a project, if progress of it found unsatisfactory. In case of termination of the project at any stage, concerned State Board shall refund full amount received by it along with accrued interest, if any to CPCB.
- c) The concerned Board shall furnish 2(two) copies of the Final Technical or Implementation Report along with a soft copy to the Committee on completion of the Project.
