1. The committee shall look in to the existing norms of health infrastructure facilities and human resources required for such facilities. They shall go through existing State norms and Indian Public Health Standard Norms.
2. The Committee shall also analyse all pending HR proposals for various health institutions and see if they are actually required to improve the service delivery of health services to the people.
3. The committee may expand their search in to missionary run or private run hospitals to see what norms they follow in terms of infrastructure and human resources. Any such member needed may be incorporated in to the committee as and when needed.
4. The committee shall come up with a recommendation for new norms of health professionals for various levels of health facilities including AYUSH facilities.
5. The committee shall come up with a recommendation of health infrastructure requirements at various health facilities.
