#### NOTIFICATION

The 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2024.

**No.POL.147/2020/Pt/63** - The Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to formulate a Scheme for placing of fund at the disposal of the Deputy Commissioners through their respective District Task Force, in order to implement the Meghalaya Residents Safety and Security Act (MRSSA) 2016 in the State.

#### 2. Introduction:

- (i). The objective of the Meghalaya Residents Safety and Security Act (MRSSA), 2016 is to ensure enhanced security vetting of the tenants and to ensure the safety and security of the citizens of the State by preventing anti-social elements from gaining shelter in the State which might be detrimental to peace and tranquility, to maintain public order and peace, to verify and regulate the tenants residing in the rented houses in the State, to establish District Task Force and facilitation centres, to facilitate effective enforcement of various laws and for safety and security of the citizen and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.
- (ii). In order to implement the provisions of the Act, the District Task Force, was constituted on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 comprising of the following:-

3. In order to implement the Meghalaya Residents Safety and Security Act (MRSSA) where the village authorities need to enter the database of tenants and landlords online and have been demanding support, a scheme is hereby created where fund for purchase of computers/ laptops/ internet facility can be provided through Deputy Commissioners. Therefore an amount of ₹ 200000/- (Rupees Two lakhs) only, shall be released to each District Task Force for administration, maintenance and recurring

expenditure of the Facilitation Centre. This amount is debit to the Head of Account as indicated at Sl. No 7.

**4. Purpose of the fund:**

The above amount will be utilized for the following purposes:

- (a). Procurement of Computers, Laptops, internet facilities /Xerox machine/ printers
- (b). TA/DA to Non-official members
- (c). Wages of Database Entry operators;
- (d). Expenditure on printing & Stationery;
- (e). Sitting fee of Non-official members;
- (f). Any other expenditure duly recommended by the District Task Force.

**5. Monitoring of the Scheme and Submission of Utilisation Certificates**

- i. The Deputy Commissioner shall maintain Cash Book, accounts, vouchers etc, relating to the fund.
- ii. The Deputy Commissioner shall submit Utilisation Certificates, quarterly, duly prepared by the Secretary of the District Task Force and countersigned by the Chairperson, (*i.e.*, Deputy Commissioner).

**6.** A proposal for Replenishment of fund under the Scheme can be submitted by the concerned Deputy Commissioner, as and when 75% of the amount released has been utilised.

**7.** The expenditure for the purpose is to be met from the Head of Account as detailed below:

**8.** The Scheme shall come into force with effect from the date of issue of this Notification.
