**NOTIFICATION**

**No.480/Programme/2025.** - Whereas, a vacancy in the Office of the Vice-President of India has occurred by reason of resignation of Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar on 21<sup>st</sup> July, 2025; and

Whereas, under clause (2) of Article 68 of the Constitution of India, an election to fill the said vacancy is required to be held as soon as possible after the occurrence of the vacancy; and

Whereas, under sub-section 4 of Section 4 of the Presidential and Vice-Presidential Elections Act, 1952 (31 of 1952), the Election Commission of India is required to appoint the dates for the election to fill the office of the Vice President of India;

Now, therefore, the Election Commission of India hereby -

(A) calls upon the Electoral College, referred to in Article 66 of the Constitution, to elect a person to fill the said vacancy in the office of the Vice-President of India, in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, the Presidential and Vice-Presidential Elections Act, 1952 (31 of 1952), and the Rules and Orders made thereunder; and

(B) in pursuance of sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the said Act, appoints -

- a) the 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2025 (Thursday), as the last date for making nominations;
- b) the 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2025 (Friday), as the date for scrutiny of the nominations;
- c) the 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2025 (Monday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures; and
- d) the 9<sup>th</sup> September (Tuesday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken.

**ELECTION TO THE OFFICE OF VICE-PRESIDENT OF INDIA**

**No.RS/VP/10/2025-T.** - WHEREAS a notification under sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Presidential and Vice-Presidential Elections Act, 1952, for the holding of an election to fill the Office of Vice-President of India has been issued by the Election Commission, I, P.C. MODY, the Returning Officer for such election, do hereby give notice that—

(i) nomination papers may be delivered by a candidate or any one of his proposers or seconders to the undersigned at his office in Room No. RS-28, First Floor, Parliament House, New Delhi, or if he is unavoidably absent, to the Assistant Returning Officers, Ms. Garima Jain, Joint Secretary/Shri Vijay Kumar, Director, Rajya Sabha Secretariat at the said office between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. on any day (other than a public holiday) not later than Thursday, the 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2025;

(ii) each nomination paper shall be accompanied by a certified copy of the entry relating to the candidate in the electoral roll for the Parliamentary constituency in which the candidate is registered as an elector;

(iii) every candidate shall deposit or cause to be deposited a sum of Rupees Fifteen Thousand only. This amount may be deposited in cash with the Returning Officer at the time of presentation of the nomination paper or deposited earlier in the Reserve Bank of India or in a Government Treasury and in the latter case a receipt showing that the said deposit of the sum has been so made is required to be enclosed with the nomination paper;

(iv) forms of nomination papers may be obtained from the above said office at the time aforesaid;

(v) the nomination papers, other than those rejected under sub-section (4) of Section 5B of the Act, will be taken up for scrutiny at the said office in Room No. F-100, Sangoshthi-2, First Floor, Parliament House, New Delhi, on Friday, the 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2025 at 11 a.m.;

(vi) the notice of withdrawal of candidatures may be delivered by a candidate, or any one of his proposers or seconders who has been authorised in this behalf in writing by the candidate, to the undersigned at the place specified in paragraph (i) above before three o'clock in the afternoon of Monday, the 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2025;

(vii) in the event of the election being contested,, the poll will be taken on Tuesday, the 9<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. at the place of polling fixed under the rules.
