- 1. Recognition of Extraterritorial Abetment:** Individuals located outside India who abet the commission of offences within India shall be held accountable under Indian law, as per Section 48 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
- 2. Law Enforcement Coordination :** Law enforcement agencies are directed to coordinate with national and international bodies to identify and prosecute individuals abetting crimes in India from abroad.
- 3. Judicial Proceedings:** Courts shall take cognizance of offences under Section 48 and proceed

with trials in accordance with the provisions of the BNSS and other applicable laws.

- 4. Public Awareness:** Efforts shall be made to educate the public about the implications of Section 48, emphasizing that abetment of crimes in India from outside its borders is punishable under Indian law.

This notification shall come into force with immediate effect.
