11. Tenderers are required to quote their rate for the items of works as shown in Annexure-I attached.
12. All works shall have to be considered as per specification in the State and I.S. Code of practices.
13. Canvassing in connection with the acceptance of Tender, is strictly prohibited and liable to disqualify the Tender without assigning any reason thereof.
14. Contractor should not employ Labour or staff of doubtful integrity. If anti-State or anti-Social elements are employed by the contractor his Tender will be cancelled and no claim to whatsoever for any lost damage will be entertained.
15. The Tenderers or his representatives may be remain present at the time of opening of Tender if they so desire, if tenderers or their representatives remain absent during the time of opening the tender shall be open in the absence and the subsequence objection will be entertained under any circumstances.
16. Firms submitting tenders should enclose copy of firms constitution and Court certified copy of power of attorney authorising one more of their agent to operate, sign and tender received payment etc. on behalf of the firms. The Department liabilities is the contracting firms of contrary only and not to the person having the power of attorney.
17. Unless otherwise mentioned in the drawing specification and items of works, are to be carried out as per the construction contained in the current PWD general specification.
18. Every page of one tender should be signed by the tenderer and every correction in rate and Clauses bear the rate initial of the tenderer before submission. The tender should be placed in sealed cover with the name of work written on top of the envelope and contractor name on the left hand side of the cover at the bottom.
19. Before handing over the work to the Department the contractor is to clear the premises and its surrounding to the satisfaction of the Executive Engineer.
20. Technically qualified and experience person will be approved by the Executive Engineer shall have to be kept inside by the contractor to supervise all the work.
21. Re-inforced cement concrete for beams to be measured from the under side of the soffit of the slab in case of I.S. beams and from top slab in case of inverted beams RCC Column shall be measured from the floor surface to the underside of beams for slab as the case may be where the column are connected to beam by hynchingand the later including with the beams where width of the beam is less than the width of columns. The extra width at the junction shall be included with beams RCC footing shall be measured from the under side of footing to the overable deptt. of footing specified in column schedule RCC Chajja to be measured from the face of Lintal/Slab/beam/Column etc.
22. Aggregates for concrete works should be of very hard stone chips granulated/crusher broken Free from impurities and to qualify the test as per I.S. Code. The cost of the test required to be borne by the contractor.
23. Only good quality river sand and free from impurities and to qualify the test as per I.S. Code should be for concrete cement works unless otherwise directed by the Department.
24. All concrete works/cement works are designed with concretes strength of m.200 concretes cube test for 7 days and 28 days taking occasionally during the mix for manner's concrete work should qualify I.S. Code 156-878 and I.S. 075-1964.

25. All fitting including aluminium anodised fitting for doors windows etc. are to be approved by the Executive Engineer before use.
26. The contractors/Firms shall have to give a declaration to the effect that they do hereby declare that they have gone through and acquainted themselves with the clauses of the contract agreement and agreeable terms and conditions stipulated in the contract agreement.
27. For any reason if the final payment of the work is not made within 6 (Six) months from the completion the validity of the security deposit shall have to be extended upto the date of the final payment.
28. Checking the materials during the progress of work may be done by the Engineer-Incharge or by his authorised representatives any time. The materials and labour for the same will have to be supplied by the contractor at his own cost.
29. The Department will not take any responsibility in case of theft or lost of any materials.
30. These terms and conditions will supersede the terms and condition of F-2 Form tender wherever the Format are at variance or in consistence with the later.
31. The money receipt towards the payment of cost of tender paper should be retained by the tenderers and enclosed the same with the tender at the time of submitting the detailed tender paper.
32. The contract must not be sublet.
33. The Short notice and detailed notice calling for tenders will be part of the Tender document.
