TERMS OF REFERENCE :- The Terms of Reference (ToR) of the Project Implementation Committee (PIC) are as follows

- To search and negotiate with the land owners in case of private land or Syiem /Sirdar/Headmen in case of Raid land a quarry, a river and a place for procurement and supply of boulders, stone aggregates, sand, bamboos and other construction materials.
- To procure and supply construction materials viz Cement, Steel, Mails, Typing wire and other construction materials and to ensure continuous supply of water.
- To hire machinery viz Bull Dozer, Angle Dozer, Rotter or Rippers, Graders, Concrete Mixer, Concrete vibrator sand others machinery that are required for site leveling, excavation of foundation, mixing of R.C.C works during casting and vehicles for transportation of construction materials and laborer to site.
- To make necessary arrangement for the supply of laborers. In case of non- tribal labourers from within the State and outside the State, the Committee shall ensure that pre-requisite documents such as labour license, trading license etc, are obtained from the concern authorities viz Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council and the State Government if required.
- To make necessary arrangement for erection of temporary camp, safe stay of labourers and construction of a temporary sheds/go-downs for keeping the steel, cements etc. jn safe custody.
- To ensure that local people are employed in the project construction as far as practicable.
- To ensure that the quality of all materials are passed and certifies by the Project Engineer/Site Engineer duly authorized by him before are used for construction.
- To ensure quality control as per IS Code of Practice and Specification, the Meghalaya State P.W. D Schedule of Rates for 2013-14 and other approved norms and standards to be directed by the project Engineer/Site/Engineer duly authorized by him before they are used for construction. A site order book to that effect shall be maintained.
- To ensure that all works done such as the volume of work, C.C works, R.C. C. works, quantities of cement, steels and other materials are measured and properly recorded in the Measurement Book (MB) by the Project Manager/Site Engineer duly authorized by him for that purpose.
- To authorized the Project Engineer to take decision on technical or Engineering matter at site that may be required during construction either unilaterally or in consultation with the Technical Adviser with regard to the design, plans, etc. of the market.
- To ensure that all payments are made as per the work done as recorded in the Measurement Book (MB).

12. To get all expenditures audited by a qualified Chartered Accountant and to submit the Utilization Certificate in the Prescribed Form GFR-19-A to the Ministry of Tribal Affairs through the Community and Rural Development Department and Planning Department.
