Functions of State Allied and Healthcare Council shall be as stipulated under Section 30 of the National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professional Act, 2021: -

- (a) To enter the name of the recognized categories, enforce the professional conduct, code of ethics and etiquette to be observed by the allied and healthcare professionals in the State and take disciplinary action, including the removal of a professionals' name from the State Register;
- (b) Ensure minimum standards of education, courses, curricula, physical and instructional facilities, staff pattern, staff qualifications, quality instructions, assessment, examination, training, research, continuing professional education;

- (c) Ensure uniformity entry examination with common counselling for admission into the allied and healthcare institutions at the diploma, undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral level under the Act;
- (d) Ensure uniformity exit or licensing examination for the allied and healthcare professionals under the Act;
- (e) Inspect allied and healthcare institutions and register allied and healthcare professionals in the State;
- (f) Ensure compliance of all the directives issued by the Commission;
- (g) Provide minimum standards frameworks for machineries, materials and services;
- (h) Approve or recognize courses and intake capacity of courses;
- (i) Impose fine upon institutions in order to maintain standards and
- (j) Perform such other functions as may be entrusted to it by the State Government for implementation of the provision of this Act.
