1. The appointments made are strictly on contract basis for not more than one year subject to satisfactory performance.
2. The instant order of appointment does not confer any right on the appointed officers to seek absorption in regular service or any claim for permanent appointment into this service.
3. Officers appointed on contract basis would not be entitled to residential accommodation, official transport, leave encashment or any other allowances/facilities as admissible to a regular Government employee.
4. The contract would be reviewed by the Department of Social Welfare, Government of Meghalaya based on the performance of the appointed officers during the contract period.
