**Sub:- District Selection Committees (DSCs) examinations-Sequence thereof.**

**No.PER(AR)43/2005/233.** - In pursuance of the Office Memorandum No.PER(AR)25/2022/24, dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 on **Qualifying Paper on knowledge of Local Language** of a particular District and the Office Memorandum No.PER(AR)25/2022/32, dated 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 on the **Syllabus for Qualifying Paper on knowledge of Local Language** and in order to bring uniformity in the sequence to be followed by all DSCs in connection to the process of recruitment, henceforth, the following order of sequence is to be maintained in the process of recruitment:-

- Step 1.** Receipt of intimation of vacancies and corresponding Reservation Rosters from Offices.
- Step 2.** Floating of Advertisements after due procedure (after due approval of the Reservation Roster by the respective Deputy Commissioners as per Office Memorandum No.PER(AR)25/2022/Pt/24, dated 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2024.)
- Step 3.** Conduct of Examinations -
- (i) **Examination on the Qualifying Paper on knowledge of Local Language of a particular District will be conducted in the first place**, which will have to be cleared by the candidates. **Failure to clear the Qualifying Paper will render a candidate ineligible to appear for subsequent stages of the recruitment.**  
  
It is to be noted that the **marks obtained in this Paper shall not carry over to subsequent stages of recruitment** as the Paper is of a qualifying nature.
  - (ii) All other qualifying tests like Physical Efficiency Tests, Typing Tests etc., wherever required, shall be conducted after the results of the examination on the Qualifying Paper on knowledge of Local Language.
  - (iii) Written Examinations.
  - (iv) Personal Interview (except for Group 'D' posts where interview has been abolished *vide* Office Memorandum No.PER(AR)58/2024/36, dated 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2025.).
- Step 4.** Declaration of results.

**No.PER(AR)25/2022/32.** - In supersession of this Department's Office Memorandum No.PER(AR)25/2022/31, dated 12<sup>th</sup> January, 2026, the Undersigned is directed to refer to office Memorandum No.PER(AR)25/2022/24, dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2023, which states that:

"It is mandatory for a candidate applying for all categories of posts which fall under the purview of the District Selection Committee to clear a qualifying paper on Knowledge of the Local Language of a particular District".

Accordingly, the syllabus for the qualifying paper on the knowledge of the local language for candidates applying for posts under the District Selection Committee (DSC) shall be as follows:

Further, under unavoidable circumstances the aforesaid meetings could also be held through Video Conference (VC) but meeting in VC mode should be limited to only once in two months.

No.673/2018 and in partial modification to Notification issued *vide* No.ENV.5/2018/367, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2025, the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to re-constitute the River Rejuvenation Committee (RRC) for preparing Action Plan for Rejuvenation of Identified Polluted River Stretches and its execution with the following members:-

**Terms of Reference in respect of the Committee.**

- (i) Preparation of Action Plan for bringing all the polluted river stretches to be fit at least for bathing purpose (i.e. BOD < 3mg/L and FC<500 MPN/100 ml).
- (ii) Monitor the execution of Action Plan.
- (iii) Action Plan will include components like identification of polluting source including functioning/status of STPs/ETPs/CETP of Solid Waste Management and processing facilities, quantification and characterisation of solid waste, trade and sewage generated in the catchment area of polluted river stretch.
- (iv) The Action Plan shall address issues relating to ground water extraction, adopting good irrigation practices, protection and management of Flood Plain Zones (FPZ), rain water harvesting, ground water charging, maintaining minimum environmental flow of river and plantation on both sides of the river.
- (v) Setting up of biodiversity parks on flood plains by removing encroachment shall also be considered as an important component of river rejuvenation.
- (vi) The Action Plan shall focus on proper interception and diversion of sewage carrying drains to the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) and emphasis should be on utilization of treated sewage so as to minimize extraction of ground water or surface water.
- (vii) The Action Plan should have speedy, definite of specific timelines for execution of steps. Provision may be made to pool the resources, utilizing funds from the State budgets, local bodies, state Pollution Board/Committee and out of Central Schemes.
- (viii) The River Rejuvenation Committee will have a website inviting public participation from educational institutions, religious institutions and commercial establishment. Achievement and failure may also be published on such website. The Committee may consider suitably rewarding those contributing significantly to the success of the project.
- (ix) The Committee is also allowed to co-opt members as and when required.

**No.FOR.2/2021/Pt/253.** - Whereas, the State Government is empowered to issue directions for the protection and improvement of the environment and for the prevention, control and abatement of environmental pollution under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, in pursuance of the delegation of powers by the Central Government *vide* Notification No.S.O. 389(E), dated 14<sup>th</sup> April, 1988;

And whereas, a "Comprehensive Study on Pollution Load of Coke Oven Plant Clusters at Soo Kilo and Umtyra, East Jaintia Hills District", conducted by M/S Enviro Infra Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Ghaziabad, has revealed significant emission of air pollutants and associated environmental impact requiring regulatory intervention;

And whereas, an Expert Technical Committee, constituted *vide* Government Notification No.FOR.2/2021/216, dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2021, has furnished its recommendations in relation to the findings of the said study;

And whereas, the findings and recommendations of the said study were evaluated and examined by the Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board, and on such evaluation, it has been indicated, on the basis of Comprehensive Environmental Pollution Index (CEPI) scores and carrying capacity assessment, that the Soo Kilo and Umtyra cluster area are approaching the threshold of classification as Critically Polluted Area;

And whereas, based on the aforesaid evaluation and assessment, the Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board, in exercise of its statutory functions under Section 17 (1)(a), 17 (1)(b), Section 17 (1)(c), Section 17 (1)(f), Section 17(1)(g) and Section 17 (1)(h) of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, has furnished its technical recommendations and advice to the State Government in relation to the prevention, control and abatement of air pollution in the said cluster areas;

And whereas, the State Government, after due consideration of the said study, recommendations of the Expert Technical Committee, and technical inputs and advice of the Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board, is satisfied that it is necessary and expedient in the interest of protection of the environment and public health to regulate the operation of coke oven plants in the said areas;

Now therefore, the Government of Meghalaya hereby issue the following directions:-

- (a) Establishment of new coke plant units or expansion of existing units shall be denied or restricted, as the case may be, within the Soo Kilo and Umtyra cluster and within a 10 (ten) Km. radius buffer zone, until further orders.
- (b) Existing units shall strictly comply with prescribed emission and effluent standards and shall install, operate and maintain approved Air Pollution Control Devices (APCDs) without fail.
- (c) The Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board shall intensify monitoring, inspection, and enforcement action in accordance with the provisions of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, and the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, as applicable.
- (d) Green belts shall be developed and maintained around industrial premises, and fugitive emissions shall be effectively controlled in accordance with prescribed environmental norms.

These directions are issued in the interest of protecting environmental quality, safeguarding public health, and ensuring sustainable industrial operations in the region.

This notification shall come into force with immediate effect and until further orders.

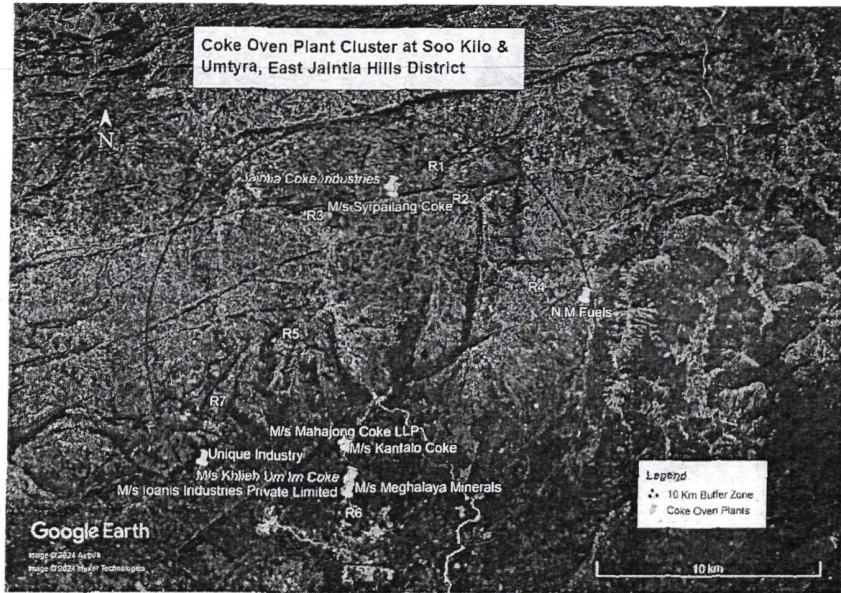


Fig: Map showing the study area at Soo Kilo and Umtyra and the 10 kms radius buffer zone
